Qualifications for
THE IMUN PROGRAM:

- Membership in a United Synagogue of Conservative Judaism affiliated congregation
- Ability to read Siddur/Humash Hebrew with facility
- Recommendation from clergy or president of congregation
- Willingness to acquire/enhance proficiency in reading Torah, chanting haftarah, leading weekday services, leading Shabbat services, preparing/delivering a d'var Torah, serving as gabbai
- Readiness to commit to full 9-day program
- Commitment to maintain the standards of Conservative Judaism as regards congregational participation, personal conduct, home life, and raising their children as Jews

The program is designed with the expectation that participants will take classes in all the skill areas. IMUN graduates return home with the ability and confidence to assume greater ritual leadership responsibilities.
